

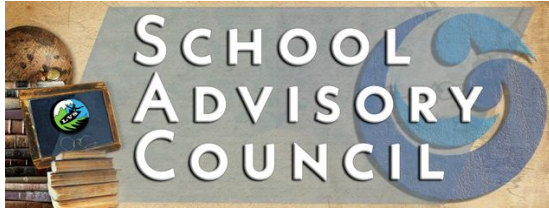

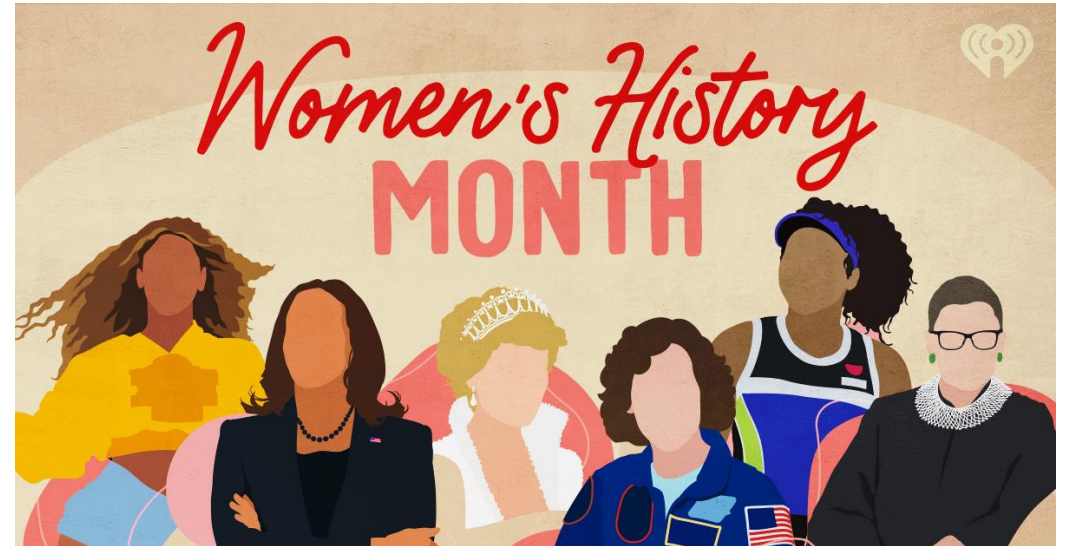
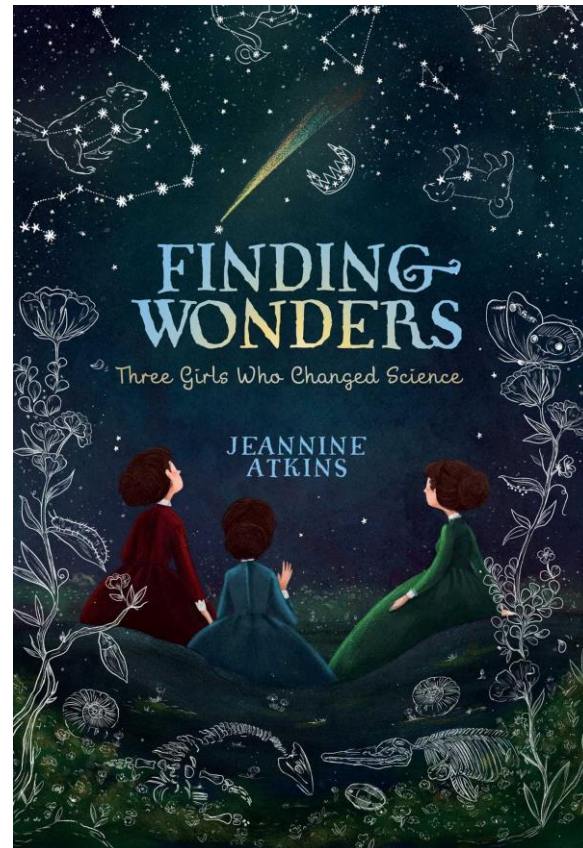
## BOOK GEMS
